TOURNAMENT CONDITIONS – LOTOS PGA-POLAND TOUR Gradi Invitational PGA Polska Gradi Golf Club April 25-26, 2015

- 1. Tournament Committee:
 - a. Tournament Director: Ania Maliszewska;b. Sport Director: Alicja Strąpoć;c. Main Rules Official: Krzysztof Pulsakowski
- 2. Tournament Committee shall publish the Local Rules before the commencement of the first tournament round.
- 3. The tournament shall be played according to the "General Conditions of PGA-Poland tournaments" and the Hard Card.
- 4. The tournament is organised under the patronage of the Polish Golf Union (PZG) and is a PZG ranking tournament.

5. Eligibility

- a. The number of players in the field shall be limited to 120. The order of entries will depend on the date of entry and submission of the entry fee by SEVEN DAYS BEFORE THE COMMENCEMENT OF THE TOURNAMENT,c
- b. Professionals: as per clause 2. of the General Conditions of PGA-Poland tournaments,
- c. Amateurs: Players with an active as well as inactive HCP will be eligible to play. Players without an active HCP will not be classified in the net category. Maximum exact HCP shall be 30.0. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to distribute 10 "wild cards" to players with an exact HCP higher than 30.0.

6. Entries and reserve list

- a. Entries can only be made through the official entry form and after payment of the entry fee to the bank account listed on <u>www.pgapolska.com</u>,
- b. The final deadline for entries and payment is SEVEN DAYS BEFORE THE COMMENCEMENT OF THE TOURNAMENT,
- c. Players who enter after the deadline described in the Tournament Conditions will have the opportunity to play in the final starting group. The starting lists for the first day of the tournament shall be prepared by a draw among the Professionals and Applicants, and by growing HCP among the Amateurs. Starting list for the second day shall be prepared based on gross Stroke Play scores from the first day.

7. Starting times

- b. Players who, despite paying the entry fee do not show on the starting tee will not be allowed to play in 3 subsequent tournaments organised by PGA-Poland.

9. Tees

- a. Ladies: yellow, course length 5196 m, including changes in length allowed by the EGA,
- b. Men: white, course length 5437 m, including changes in length allowed by the EGA.

Amateurs:

- a. Ladies: yellow, course length 5196 m, including changes in length allowed by the EGA,
- b. Juniors under 12 : course length 4505 m, including changes in length allowed by the EGA,
- c. Men, juniors over 12: white, course length 5437 m, including changes in length allowed by the EGA.

10. CUT

72 best gross Stroke Play scores and ties will make the CUT to the second round.

11. Entry fees

- c. Professionals from outside PGA-Poland 100 Euro

- g. Sponsors' guests and wild cards: at the discretion of the Tournament Director.

- c. Trophies for I, II, III place in the Amateur 36-hole Gross Stroke Play classification,
- d. Trophies for I, II, III place in the Amateur $_{3}6\mbox{-}hole$ Net Stroke Play classification,
- e. Best lady in the Amateur 36-hole Gross & Net Stroke Play classification,
- f. Best junior in the Amateur 36-hole Gross & Net Stroke Play classification,

13. Information

All information related to the tournament, such as members of the Tournament Committee, starting lists, communiqués will be posted on the official Notice Board at the Tournament Centre and on the website <u>www.pgapolska.com</u>.

14. Ties

Professionals:

- a. In case of ties for the first place in Gross Stroke Play classification there will be a "sudden death" play-off immediately after the conclusion of the second round. The play-off holes will be announced by the Tournament Committee before the commencement of the play-off,
- b. In case of ties for second and further places, the players will be classified ex-aequo.

Amateurs:

- c. In case of ties for the first, second and third place in Gross & Net Stroke Play classification the following count-back method will be used: better final round, better last 9, 6, 3, 1 hole of the final round,
- d. In case of ties for further places, the players will be classified ex-aequo.

The last 9 holes for the purpose of the count-back are holes 10-18 of the course.

PZG Ranking points will be allotted according to the PZG 2015 Ranking Regulations.

Prizes for the Gross & Net classifications are mutually exclusive. The Gross category is the main category, and players receiving prizes in Gross category will not be included in prizes for Net category.
